FINANCIAL UPDATE: October pledge receipts were down. Through 83% of the year, we have received 85% of budgeted pledges. Plate and unpledged offerings remain strong. Expenses were lower during the month bringing the YTD overspending to \$4800. Plate and unpledged offerings remain strong and are the main reason for our bottom line being favorable to budget so far. Our capital account balances are a low \$10,400.
